Let's learn about our planet together

LEARNING IN NATURE

Know the place where you live



"Think globally, act locally" is a movement that urges people to consider the ecology and take action in their communities. To act locally, you need to know the place where you live. We explore the surroundings of our town, and every time we find new and interesting places.

The children learn to identify trees and plants species; they see how and where insects live. They understand the function of the forest. The kids discover caves, streams, and lakes, hear, smell and touch everything they can. That is real "all senses" learning.



The children practice observation skills and patience, but also practical skills like making a fire. They learn the rules of nature protection.
